

Parking Garage at 24 Colony St. now open (9/17/17)

You may now park in the public parking garage at 24 Colony St next to the church; the entrance driveway is just to the left of the church driveway as you come off Colony St.

- Parking is free all-day Saturday and Sunday (and Federal holidays)
- During weekdays (including evenings), parking is free for the first two hours, but any time over two hours (even a minute) will cost \$7 for that day.
- There are two entrances/exits:
 - One on Church St. is for residents of 24 Colony St. only – this is the first floor of the garage and is underground
 - One accessed from Colony St. – this is the entrance folks using First Congregational Church would use
- As you enter the parking garage, you will be prompted to push a button, take the ticket that is dispensed, the gate will then open, and you can then park anywhere on that level or the one above.
- When you leave the garage and owe no money, insert the ticket at the exit, and the gate will open so you can drive away.
- If you owe the \$7, you may pay by credit card (but not cash) at the Colony St. exit. If you are unable to pay by credit card, you must walk down to the Church St. exit, pay the \$7 in cash and receive a second ticket from the attendant which will now allow you to walk back to your car and exit through the Colony St. exit (complete this exit within 15 minutes of receiving the second ticket or you may be charged an additional \$7).

It is really not complicated, unless you owe \$7 and do not wish to pay by credit card.
